ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2024-03

**IN THE MATTER OF PRESCRIBING FUNCTIONS-MISDEMEANOR
PROBATION SERVICES**

Idaho Code § 31-878 provides that misdemeanor probation services shall perform such functions as prescribed by the administrative district judge in each judicial district.

The court hereby identifies the function of misdemeanor supervised probation as the facilitation of the pro-social adjustment of offenders under supervision to prevent further criminal behavior and to ensure successful compliance with the terms and conditions of probation.

The Idaho Association of Counties Misdemeanor Probation Planning Committee has approved and adopted Idaho Standards for Misdemeanor Probation Services, which were revised in 2023.

Misdemeanor probation services departments in this judicial district shall establish, at a minimum, policies and procedures in accordance with the 2023 revised Idaho Standards for Misdemeanor Probation Services.¹

Prior Administrative Order 2011-001 is hereby replaced by this Administrative Order 2024-03.
